Grit, Reliability, Perseverance, Responsibility


**Choose Two Moral Character Skills:** 

Empathy, Honesty, Loyalty, Service







### Strategies for Coaching Character

- → Make character a recurring topic in preseason meetings
- → Regularly hold team dialogues throughout the season
- → Meet with players individually
- → Goal setting
- → Pair team members for weekly reflections



### Strategies for Coaching Character

- → Utilize surveys (exit surveys)
- → Utilize film
- → Encourage responsibilities that reflect culture
- → Assist students in identifying positive role models
- → Reframe challenges or missteps into learning opportunities




