(1 yard in length, 6 inches beyond goal line and touch line, and 11 yards from corner located at each corner of field)

Recommended Field Dimensions
110 yards by 65 yards.

- 100-Yard Line:** A horizontal line 100 yards from each end zone.
- 110-Yard Line:** The end line, 110 yards from each end zone.

Key features and dimensions include:

- Touchline:** The side lines of the field, 65 yards apart.
- Halfway Line:** The center line, 50 yards from each end zone.
- 9" Spot:** A spot on the halfway line, 10 yards from each end zone.
- 10 yd. Radius:** A circular area with a 10-yard radius centered on the 9" spot.
- Flag:** A flag is attached to the waist of each player. The pole is a minimum 1" diameter, and the flag is a minimum 5" high. The flag is installed touching the outer edge of the lines at the corner.
- 1 yd. Radius:** A circular area with a 1-yard radius centered on the 9" spot.
- 10 yds., 18 yds., 12 yds., 6 yds., 20 yds., 44 yds., 55 to 80 yds.:** Various dimensions indicating the placement of the 10-yard line, 20-yard line, 30-yard line, 40-yard line, 50-yard line, 60-yard line, 70-yard line, 80-yard line, and 90-yard line.
- 100 to 120 yds.:** A dimension indicating the distance from the 100-yard line to the 120-yard line.

NOTE: An engineered natural turf soccer field should have a minimum of one-and-one-half percent (1.5%) slope for fields which are surface drained. For natural turf fields with a sub-surface drain system the slope should be no less than one (1.0%) percent. For synthetic turf fields with a sub-surface drain system the slope should be no less than one half of one (0.5%) percent. Slope is measured from center to side.
