- **GenNext** is a collaboration between The NAMM Foundation and The College Music Society (CMS) that offers college-age students and faculty access to career and professional development opportunities by providing resources for future music industry leaders.
- Music Education Days (MED) enables school music teachers and administrators to gather for sessions in collaboration with partners like NAfME and TI:ME.
- The Nonprofit Management Institute connects music service organizations with best practices in fundraising, leadership, and board management through a partnership with Young Audiences for Learning.
- Community Music Making offers music-making opportunities and resources for NAMM members and community organizations through Make Music Day and NAMM Show activities.
- Best Communities for Music Education honors community support for music education in schools.
- Music Research continues to be an important investment in understanding the benefits of music education for physical and mental health as well as for attendance and participation in schools.




