#### Increased Penalties Passed by the Board of Directors

#### Bad Actors Should Suffer Increased Penalties

A Supplemental Disqualification is triggered when a Coach or contestant is ejected from a contest and a component of the disqualification is the any of the following actions: confronting an official, coach, or contestant; physically contacting an official, coach, or contestant; directing foul or vulgar language/gestures toward an official, coach, contestant or spectator(s); using ethnic or racially insensitive comments. This section is NOT intended for other infractions described as "rules of the game" or actions which do not meet the above criteria. Established 2020

## Creation of the Junior Officials Program

#### Open to 16- and 17-year-olds

- 625 Applied 250 (approx.) completed reg.
- May work 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 9<sup>th</sup> grade contests only
- PIAA waives registration fees (\$40)
- Still require:
  - Testing
  - Meeting attendance
  - State mandated clearances
