- Polarizing political environment, legislative involvement, legal challenges


We need to (1) ask hard questions under massive public scrutiny, (2) stay true the beliefs of our diverse team, and (3) <u>listen</u>.

Having a "How Can We Serve You?" Mentality

Addition of the WIAA Satellite Office

- Milwaukee satellite office opened in 2022
- Surrounding member schools account for one-third of membership
- Disconnect between area schools and WIAA headquarters in Stevens Point, WI
- Many area schools have part-time athletic directors with limited ability to leave classroom during school day

Creation of WIAA Student-Athlete Leadership Team

What is the WIAA Student-Athlete Leadership Team?

- Collection of 27 diverse student-athlete leaders from member schools across the state
- Provide student input to WIAA staff, member schools and the Board of Control
- Communicate needs and challenges facing today's student athletes
- Develop leadership skills in Team members and learn more about the sports industry
- Inspire thoughtful, student-led action that supports the purpose and desired outcomes of the Student-Athlete Leadership Team

Ad Hoc Committee Development Active Listening

Competitive Balance Committee

An ad hoc committee consisting of 11 superintendents/district administrators, six athletic directors, one principal and one principal/athletic director proposed the performance factor process, which was approved by a 265-115 membership vote at the 2023 Annual Meeting for implementation in 2024-25. The initiative promotes school programs that reach a threshold of tournament success based on a performance point system allocated over a three-year period.



Ad Hoc Committee Development Active Listening

Calendar and Coaching Contact Committee

The ad hoc committee is to represent the diverse voices of the membership in evaluating season lengths, game maximums, and coaching contact with the primary goal to promote a balanced, education-based athletic experience for student-athletes.

Administrative Meetings

- Weekly meetings each leadership staff gets 5 minutes <u>"the talking stick" concept</u>
- Agenda bullet points shared with entire staff
- Variety of inspiration <u>quotes</u>, <u>make you smile</u>, <u>staff appreciation</u>, <u>self-reflection</u>, <u>history</u>
 <u>of sport</u>, <u>sportsmanship</u>



Helping our Staff Be the Best Version of Ourselves

DEI training

- Hired an outside entity
- Staff and Individual goals
- No "wrong" place to be it's an awareness and commitment to growth

Staff One-on-Ones - Reflection, Feedback and Growth

- 2 times/year
- Consider different types of questions so all staff feel comfortable
- "How can we be more efficient in our work?"
- What is your vision for our team? For yourself?



Lunch & Learn (Staff)

- Staff to be able to sign-up on topics where they want to learn more
- Optional
- Set topics with step-by-step walkthrough
- Question and Answer



Electronic Seeding (Membership)

- Previously results for electronic seeding took several hours to generate
- Now generates in under a minute
- Outputs for media partners with broadcasted reveal show to reduce errors and time
- Can easily run scenarios for proposed criteria so committee can review and make decisions



Chat Bot (Staff & Membership)

- Built off of knowledgebase
- Deflects questions being received via phone or email by staff
- Information presented to membership by a chat bot on website



Forms (Staff & Membership)

- Previously data in many forms retrieved by IT and provided in report or spreadsheets
- Using JotForm, now available for staff that needs them including:
 - Email notifications (staff & membership)
 - Submissions available in spreadsheets (staff)
 - Printable and professional PDFs (staff & membership)
 - Reports (staff)
 - Legally binding e-signature (staff & membership)
