Rules Revisions

1.

Substitutions are permitted during a temporarily suspended game such as a water break during hot weather.
2.

An injured player must leave the field if a coach or appropriate health-care provider is beckoned, including the goalkeeper.
3.

A number is required on the front of the uniform, which may be on the jersey and/or the shorts.
4.

A coach or team personnel cannot speak with a referee during intervals between periods, unless beckoned by a referee.
5.

Officials can apply a misconduct penalty to the head coach if team or bench misconduct occurs.
6.

Definitions in Rule 18 were removed and integrated into the appropriate rules, eliminating unnecessary duplication.
