Rules Revisions

1.

Beginning with the 2026-27 school year, state associations may adopt the use of a non-smooth or textured volleyball.
2.

Team members may wear black, white or gray undergarments in addition to undergarments that match the predominant color of the uniform top/bottom. All team members, other than the libero, wearing an undergarment must wear the same color.
3.

Beginning July 1, 2029, the number on the front of the uniform must be centered on the upper half of the uniform top.
4.

The second referee is no longer required to carry and use a lineup card to check the starting line-ups, allowing officials to use each coach’s submitted lineup sheet to check the starting lineup.
5.

Multiple contacts by a player in a single attempt to play the ball on the second team hit is no longer a multiple contact fault if the ball is next contacted by a teammate.
6.

The penalty administration for an illegal libero replacement is an unnecessary delay if identified before contact of serve and an illegal alignment if identified after contact of serve.
